4. Turn cards over in turns to find pairs



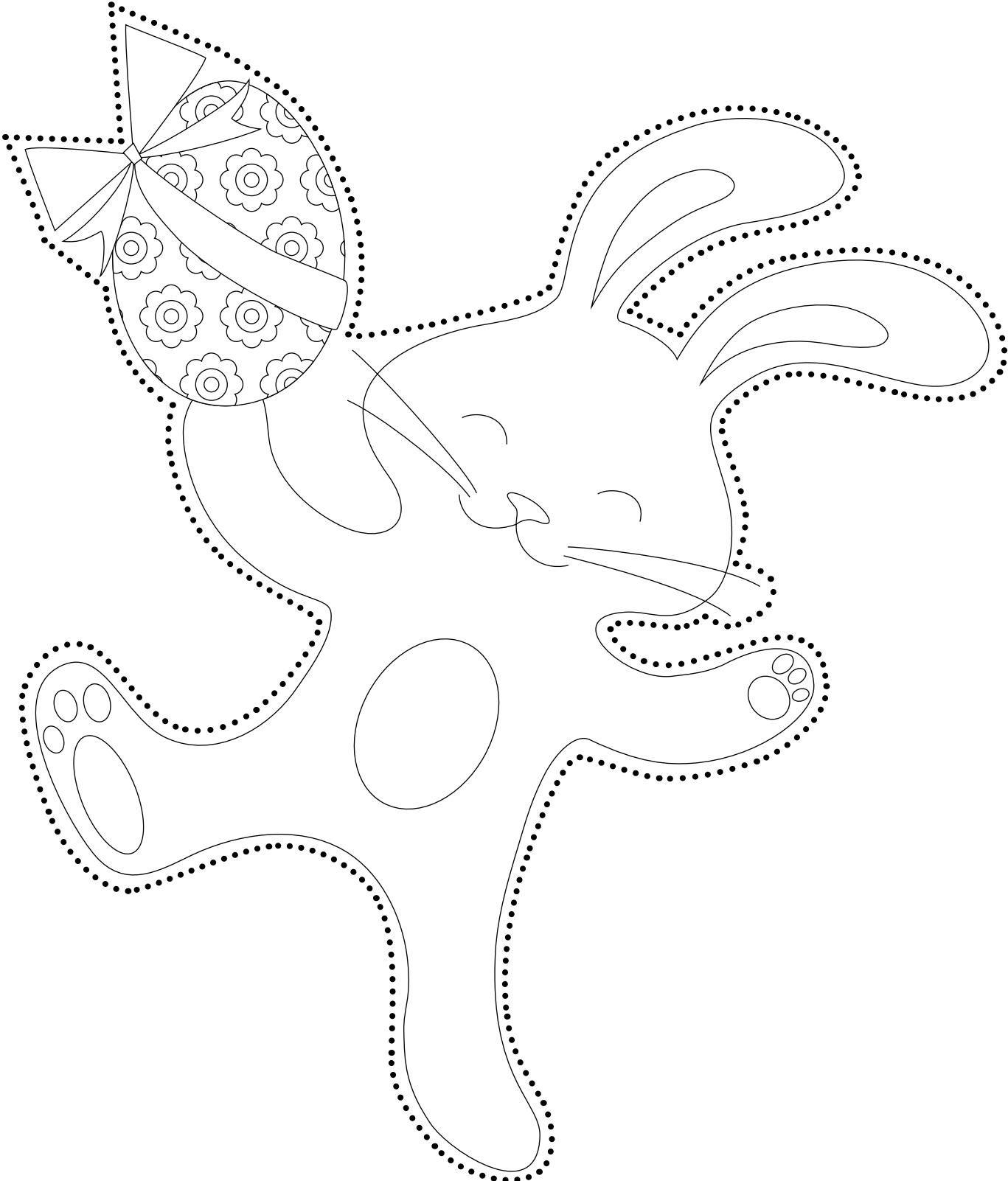
# How colourful is that then?

Here, with colouring, too!



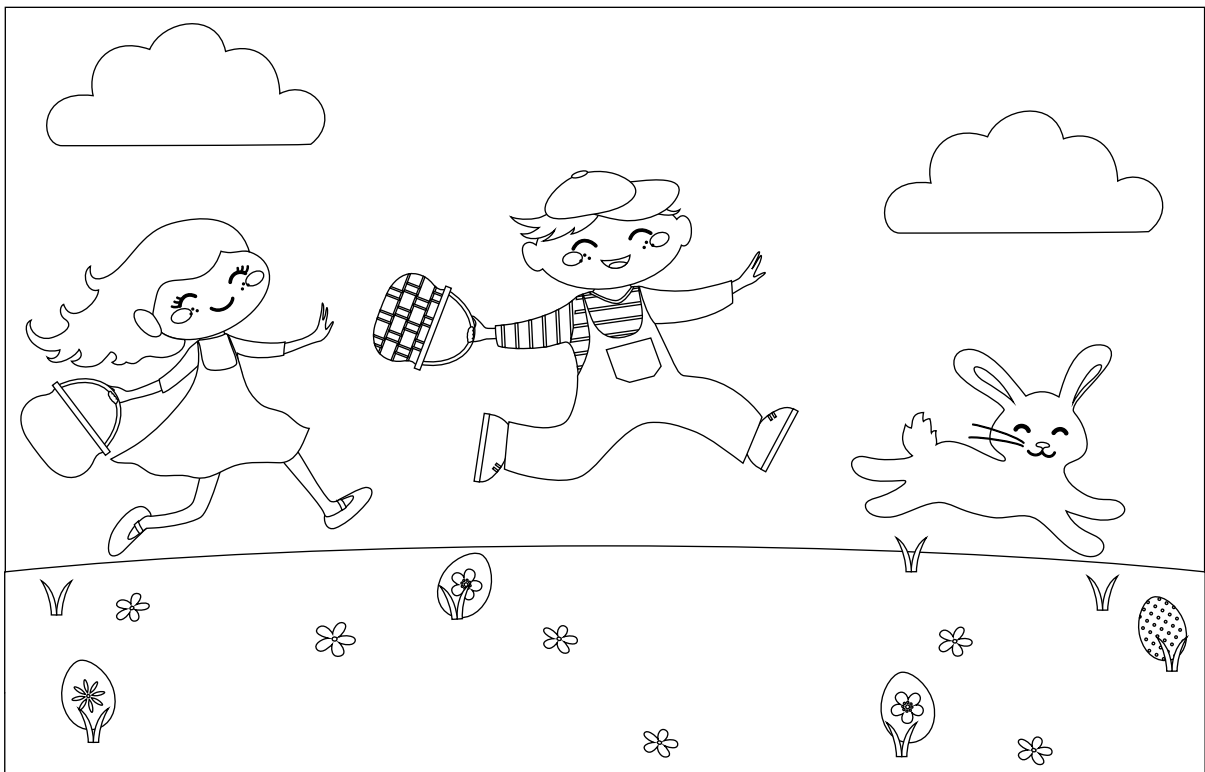
# Cut out for Easter

Simply colour in Hoppy and the egg and prick along the dotted line with a needle. Place a piece of foam or cardboard underneath for safety. Then detach the picture.



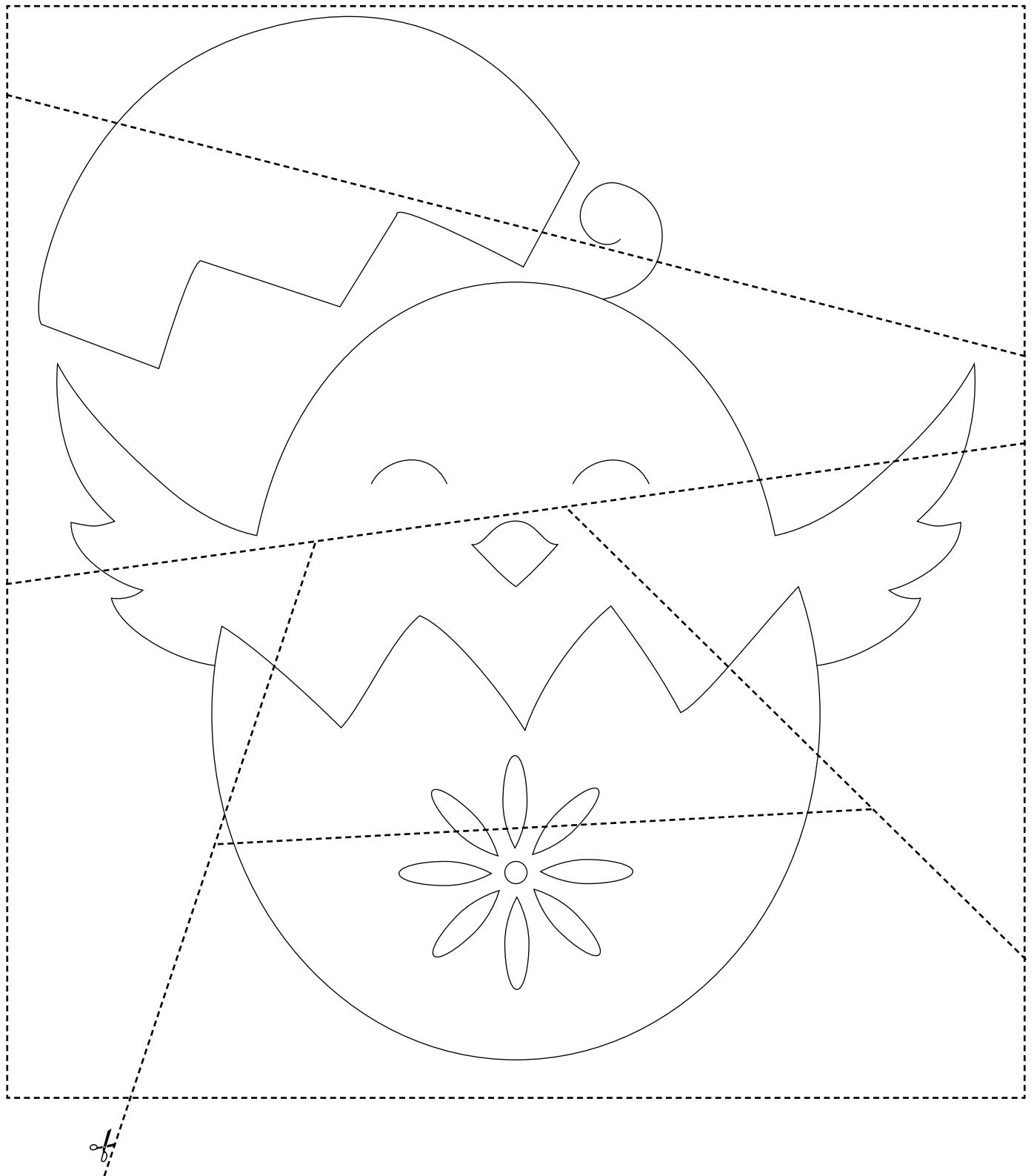
# Uh oh!

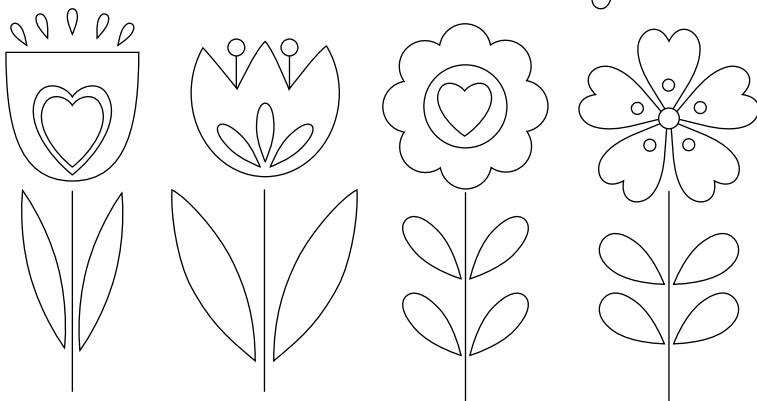
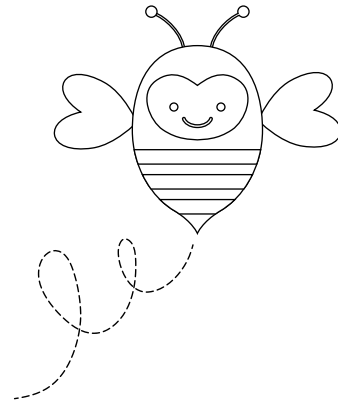

# Get to the nest!

A game for 2 to 4 players. The player that lands on the nest first, wins. You'll need a dice and 2 to 4 playing pieces. Important: if a person throws a 6 they miss a turn. Let's go!

The board consists of a 7x8 grid of circles. The path starts at a blue circle with the word **START** at the bottom center. The path ends at a blue circle with the word **FINISH** at the top center, which is connected to a nest containing three blue eggs. The nest is on a branch with pink flowers, with a bee flying nearby. There are also three yellow chicks at the start of the path. Special instruction circles are placed at various points: **Miss a turn.** (orange), **Go back two places.** (green), and **Go forward one space.** (pink). A dragonfly and a butterfly are also illustrated on the board.
